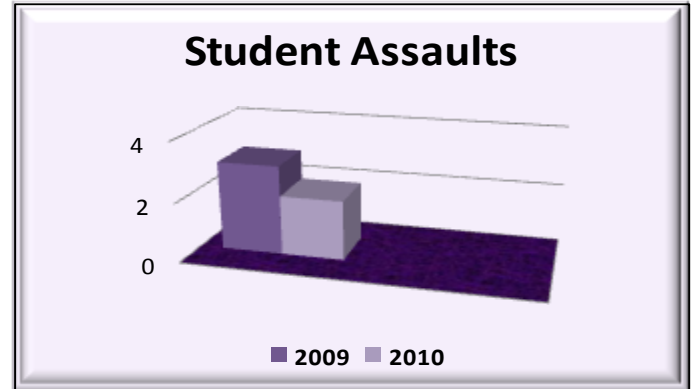
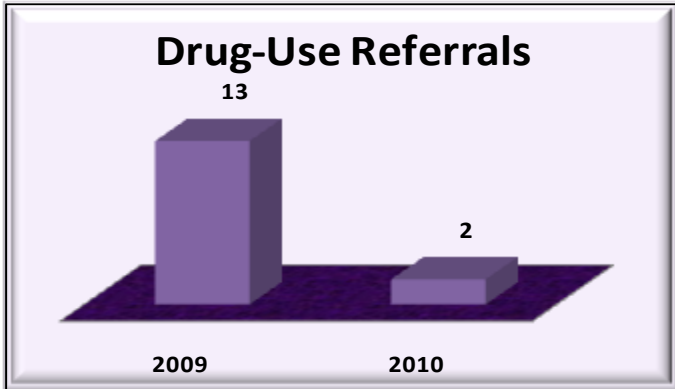

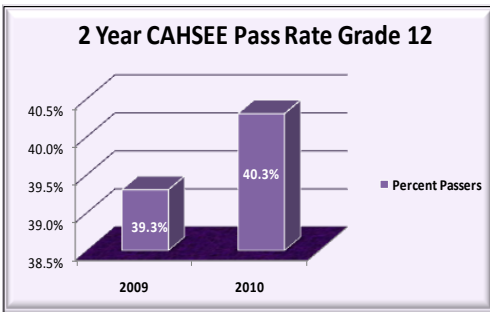
# SCHOOL CLIMATE AND SAFETY

The SSPT at North Campus is committed to ensuring that students have a safe learning environment, free from the distractions commonly associated with continuation high school setting. **We have recently instituted a Student Attendance Intervention Team**, lead by our SRO and the site supervisors, in cooperation with the administrative and counseling staff. The SSPT has been instrumental in establishing an effective mentorship program. **The mentorship program is spearheaded by our SRO, Site Supervisor and counseling staff and has successfully resolved many peer and family conflicts.** **The graphs below show a reduction in both referrals related to drug use and student assaults.** The SSPT has established a plan to implement several awareness programs which address many health related concerns. Some of the programs include, drug and alcohol awareness, violence prevention, sexual harassment, gang awareness and alternative resolution strategies.



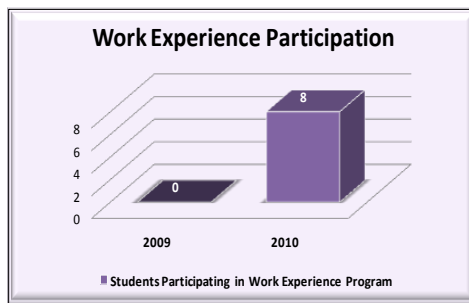

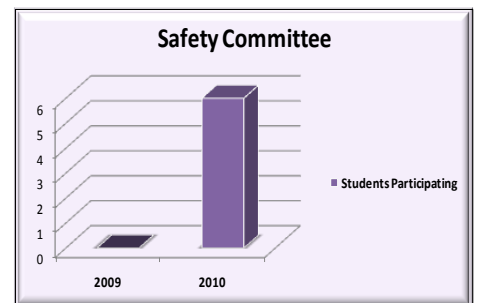
**Our seniors have made incremental improvement on the CASHEE**
